ANGELA MANCUSO TO HEAD NEW ARCLIGHT TELEVISION DIVISION

LOS ANGELES, MAY 12, 2009 – Angela Mancuso, former president of Cable Entertainment for Universal Studios and a producer with both Universal and ABC TV, has been named to head the new television division of Arclight Films, it is announced by Arclight managing director Gary Hamilton.

Stated Hamilton: “Our plans for the made for television division include production of one hour format series, two hour movies and mini-series.

At Arclight she will also be involved in the development and production of features.
